1. Include your name, address, and phone number.

3. Describe when you began volunteering and what type of activities you took part in. Please explain separately activities you were involved in at school from those outside of school.
4. Answer the following question using your experience:
  - Why is volunteerism important to your school and community, and how did your volunteerism make a difference?
5. Provide two letters of recommendation from someone associated with your volunteer work. This should not include counseling staff or relatives. Only one of these letters of recommendation can come from the teaching staff of Comstock Park Public Schools.

The Educational Foundation will review all correctly completed applications. Incomplete applications or ones that are turned in beyond the deadline date will not be considered.

Trustees of the Educational Foundation will review all applications. Please return your completed application to the Guidance Office by March 1, 2010. Applications will not be accepted after the deadline has passed.
